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| <u>Monday</u> | <p><u>Calendar & Weather</u></p> <p>What day is it today? Can you have a look outside your window and describe the weather? Have a go at drawing a picture and write a sentence about what you can see.</p> | <p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Can you write the numbers 1-20 on paper? Ask somebody to hide them around your home and try to find them all. Put them in order from 1 to 20 to check if you have found them all. Which number is smallest/biggest?</p> | <p><u>Music</u></p> <p>Can you use some pans in your kitchen with different beaters to make a variety of sounds? Try using a fork, a wooden spoon or a plastic spatula. Do you notice anything different about the sounds that they make?</p> |
| <u>Tuesday</u> | <p><u>PSHE/Feelings</u></p> <p>Watch 'My Many Coloured Days' by Dr Zeuss. How do you feel today? Which colour would you use to describe how you feel? Can you draw or paint a picture to show how you feel?</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Lum83DLPXIw</p> | <p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Play Snakes and Ladders in the pack that was given to you at the beginning of the year. Roll the dice and take it in turns to move your counter along the board. Can you move your counter the correct amount of jumps? Who is winning? How do you know?</p> | <p><u>Family Box</u></p> <p>Look through old videos and photos of you and your family and talk about how old you were and what you were doing in the photos. Can you talk about who is in your family and who is special to you?</p> |
| <u>Wednesday</u> | <p><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>Practise the Phase 2 and 3 sounds, can you join in with the sounds on the videos?</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hCBzNnSSxds</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=p7hRbrpq5Bo</p> <p>Today we are learning the sound 'igh'. Can you read these words - light, high, night, bright? What do these words mean? Write the sentence 'the sun is bright'.</p> | <p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Watch this song on 3d shapes to help you to learn the different names (remember, a 3d shape is a fat shape and a 2d shape is a flat shape). Ask somebody at home to say a 3d shape and have a go at finding an object in your home which is that shape. Can you describe the shape? Does it have any corners? 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| <p><u>Thursday</u></p> | <p><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>Practise reading the high frequency words that you know so far. Ask somebody to help you write the words - boat, goat, float and ask them to hide the words around your home. Can you find them and shout the words when you see them?</p> | <p><u>Topic/Design</u></p> <p>Follow the link to find out how to make your own nature journal. | <p><u>Friday</u></p> | <p><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>Ask somebody at home to help you write down two sets of these tricky words - <i>go, come, here, said, play, you, she, me</i>. Divide the words so that you have one set and another person has the other set. Play snap and have a go at reading each word as you turn them over.</p> | <p><u>Topic/Literacy</u></p> <p>Listen to Miss Adams' story 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' on the home learning page. Can you make your own story based on this book by drawing the character and food? Is your main character a caterpillar or a different insect? How many fruits does your character eat? Have a go at writing some sentences to tell your story.</p> | <p><u>Freestyle Fridays</u></p> <p>Play your favourite music and take it in turns with your family to dance your best moves in the middle of the room! Whose dancing did you like the best? Why did you like their dancing?</p> |
