Are you on a low income or receiving certain benefits?

You could be eligible for a Healthy Start card. This can be used to buy fruit, vegetables, milk and infant formula for you and your children. You'll get money added onto it every 4 weeks:



- £4.25 each week of your pregnancy from the 10th week
- £8.50 each week for children from birth to 1 year old
- £4.25 each week for children between 1 and 4 years old

Your money will stop when your child is 4 years old, or if you do not get benefits that make you eligible.

When you apply, make sure:

- Your details are up to date with HMRC or DWP
- You enter your details as they are written on your benefits award letter
- All your children under 4 are named on your Universal Credit claim
